Personal Information

The Whats On The Menu Site collects different types of personal identifiable information (PII) such as name, address, email address and phone number.

When you download and use the Smart Phone Apps, we automatically collect information on the type of device you use, operating system version, and the device identifier. We do not ask for, access or track any location based information from your *Mobile* at any time

We send you push notifications from time-to-time in order to update you about any events or promotions that we may be running. If you no longer wish to receive these types of communications, you may turn them off at the device level. To ensure you receive proper notifications, we will need to collect certain information about your device such as operating system and user identification information.

We also collect third party personal information from customers, including their name, address, telephone number, email address, and credit card number and expiration date.

This PII is used to charge for product orders and ship product and for no other purposes.

We will collect third party personal information from those persons in your Smartphone's personal contact list that you elect for emailing or texting when participating in the Customer Loyalty Program's Refer-A-Friend function.

Supplementation of Information
